This piece of jewelry was also designed around 1900. A much preferred motif of the Art Nouveau period were 'horns of plenty' out of which came pouring globes, symbolizing the rich and the full. The heavy pendant is very skillfully attached to the chain, exactly as shown on Vogeler's detailed drawing. Here too the opal symbolizes a mirror.
