Cuff Links - Bernhard Hoetger, late 1920's

Bernhard Hoetger, sculptor, architect and designer, created this pair of cuff links for himself at the end of the 1920s. Following Hoetger's design and instructions, the turquoise pieces, with a rough veining, are differently set, accentuating the character of the handicraft. The back piece of the cuff links show old Nordic symbols in an expressionistic style. The variety of the stones and the almost roughly crafted golden parts create the special thrill and tension, which is typical for Hoetger's expressionist sculptural work.
